

Duties of the Governor's Cabinet

Three students are selected from each district to be members of the governor's cabinet. The governor will appoint commissioners from this student body to work on selected topics (ie. environmental, conservation, health & safety, etc.) The responsibility of each cabinet officer is to attend meetings of the legislative committees dealing with his topic, take notes on important bills, attend floor debates on bills in their area, act as the governor's lobbyist on such bills, and report to and advise the governor on such bills when they reach the governor's desk. Students with knowledge in a given area should apply for a cabinet position. For example, a delegate who is interested in conservation and has been involved in wildlife protection programs would make an ideal commissioner of environmental conservation.

- Cabinet members will advise and council with the governor on all matters concerning his/her duties.
- Must possess leadership skills.
- Must have a good working knowledge of parliamentary procedure.
