Bills Passed

The following is a list of the youth legislation passed in November by the 2006 Middle School House and Senate.

House Bills

H0041 A bill to mandate that all Michigan restaurants have a nutritional fact guide within their menus.

H0044 A bill to mandate that all Michigan drivers over the age of 65 are required to pass a road test to ensure they are capable of driving.

H0106 A bill to mandate that all children with disabilities that have required health treatment should have their insurance cover all expenses of the needed therapy.

Senate Bills

S 0077 A bill to mandate that all children from grade 6 and up should receive tutoring if they are receiving below a C in the middle of the semester.

S0088 A bill to mandate that all towns in Michigan with a population of at least 10,000 residences must provide curbside recycling pickup.
